She is state licensed Psychotherapist in the Netherlands, studied as main modality Group Psychotherapy and Psychodrama in Gent (B.) and followed lots of other psychotherapy courses and trainings in Behaviour-, Family-, Hypno- and Hermeneutic psychotherapy at several universities. She gave lots of presentations and workshops at many institutes and congresses all over the world. She wrote many articles and some chapters in books, mostly about psychodrama and/or psychotherapy.

She is TEP Psychodrama of the Nordic Board and the Dutch Belgian Board of Examiners, international Expert for Psychodrama at EAP (TAC). She was Researcher at 'KenVaK' Research Centre of 'Zuyd University for Applied Sciences', Heerlen NL and PhD candidate of Maastricht University of Economy, department Marketing of Services, on the subject: implementing client centered team learning at a general hospital. She is psychotherapist with long year experience in psychiatric hospital and since then working in her own practice. Besides she is director of the School of Psychodrama in the Netherlands.

She is founder and co-founder of many organizations. With longer widespread Dutch and international board member experiences, she served as Chairperson of the Federation of European Psychodrama Training Organisations FEPTO, and of the Dutch Association for Psychotherapy NAP. She was Co-Chairperson of the European Standard Training Committee ETSC of EAP, and member of the Research committee for European Psychotherapist Competencies.
